

# Hunting at Lake Mendocino









#### What You Need to Know

#### Before You Go....


#### **General Information**

- Upland & Small game hunting season start dates vary for each species.
   Refer to California Department of Fish and Game regulations for specific dates/species.
- ◆ ALL hunters must register at Park Headquarters for each season to sign a waiver, and check in no more than 5 days prior to their proposed hunts. Check-ins can either be in person M-F 7:30-4:00, or by calling Park Ranger Wayne @ 707-489-8562 or Park Ranger Josh @ 309-762-8364.
- ♦ Hunting is limited to small game, such as rabbit, squirrel, and upland and migratory game birds including quail, dove, geese and duck.
- ♦ Hunting in Wildlife Management Area only (see map).
- Hunters must remain on US Army Corps of Engineers property.
   Surrounding property, including the barn near Miti, is private property.
   Trespassing is not allowed.
- Hunting not permitted within 100 yards of campgrounds including Miti Campground and boat hunting must be within 100 yards of shore high water line bordering the designated hunting area.
- All hunters must follow California hunting regulations and US Army Corps of Engineers Title 36 park regulations.
- Motorized vehicles are prohibited in the Wildlife Management Area.

#### **Firearms**

- ♦ Hunting is permitted with the use of archery, air rifle .177-.25 caliber, and shotgun with use of steel or lead shot only.
- ♦ The use of pistols, rifles and shotgun slugs are prohibited.
- ◆ Firearms MUST be unloaded when transported outside the hunting area, and are allowed at Lake Mendocino ONLY during hunting season. All other times of the year, firearms are prohibited at Lake Mendocino.
