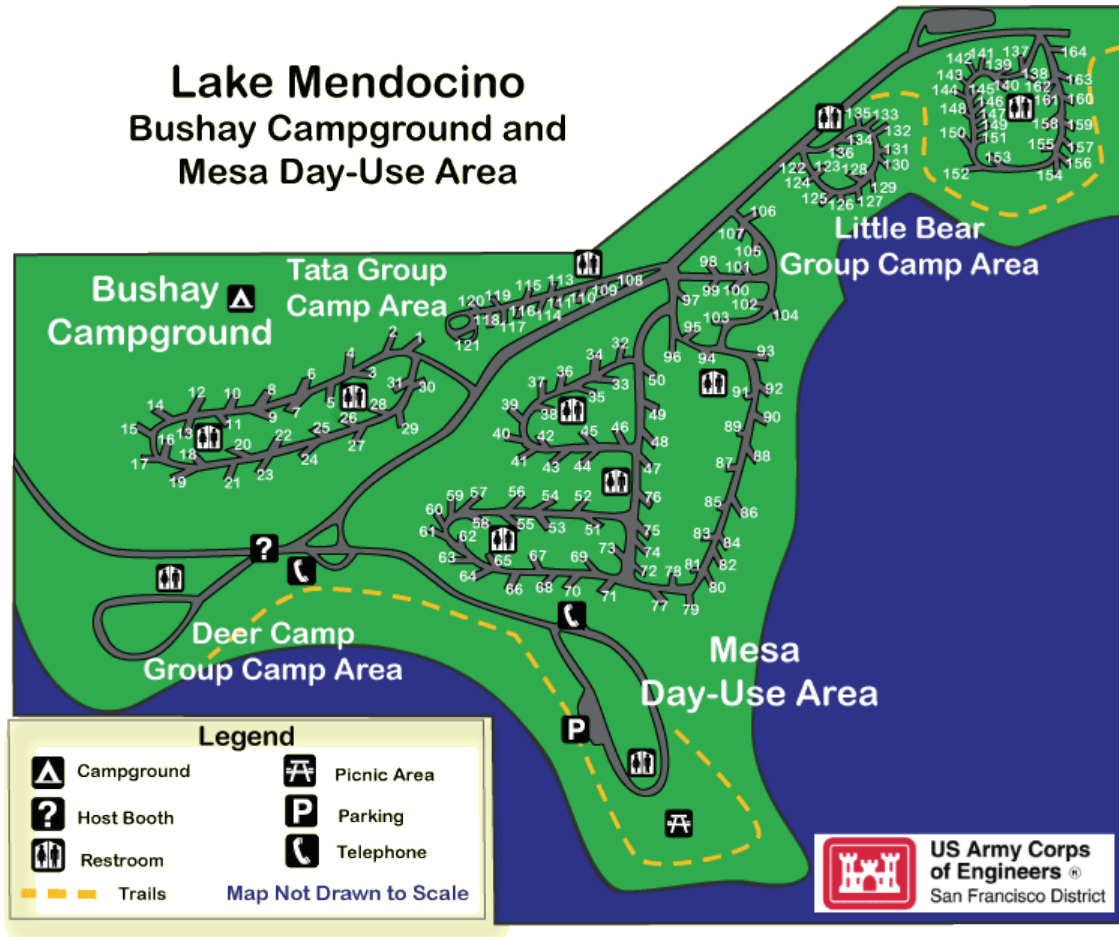


Lake Mendocino Bushay Campground and Mesa Day-Use Area

Directions

From 101 South (San Francisco, Santa Rosa, Ukiah)

Follow Highway 101 North. Take Highway 20 east approximately 5 miles North of Ukiah. Follow Highway 20 East for approximately 3 miles. Just after you see Lake Mendocino on your right, you will cross a tall bridge. Take the first left after the bridge. Follow the road under the bridge and along the river until you reach the Host Booth at the top of the hill.

From 101 North (Eureka, Willits, Fort Bragg)

Follow Highway 101 South. Take Highway 20 east approximately 15 miles South of Willits. Follow Highway 20 East for approximately 3 miles. Just after you see Lake Mendocino on your right, you will cross a tall bridge. Take the first left after the bridge. Follow the road under the bridge and along the river until you reach the Host Booth at the top of the hill.

From 20 East (Sacramento)

Take Highway 20 West from Williams. Follow for approximately 2 hours or 80 miles past Clearlake and Blue Lakes. Approximately 2 miles after the Potter Valley turn-off you will see a sign for Lake Mendocino Recreation Area. Take the first right after the sign. Follow the road under the bridge and along the river until you reach the Host Booth at the top of the hill.
