SUBJECT: Draft LTMS Management Plan Scoping Meeting of July 8, 1998

A scoping meeting regarding the preparation of the Draft Management Plan for the long Term Management Strategy (LTMS) will be held on July 8, 1998, from 9:30 a.m. to 11:50 a.m., at the San Francisco Regional Water Quality Control Board Office in Oakland.

The primary focus of this meeting will be potential strategies for future allocation of in-Bay disposal capacity under Alternative 3, which will be the preferred alternative in the *Final Environmental Impact Statement/Programmatic Environmental Impact Report (EIS/R) for the Long Term Management Strategy for the Placement of Dredged Material in the San Francisco Bay Region* currently scheduled to be issued in August 1998. The attached discussion paper presents potential strategies for allocating in-Bay disposal capacity.
