

# Hunting at Lake Mendocino

## General Information

- ◆ Small game hunting only from October 21, 2006 - January 28, 2007.
- ◆ Hunting is limited to small game, such as rabbit and squirrel, and upland and migratory game birds including quail, dove and duck.
- ◆ Hunting in Wildlife Management Area only (see map).
- ◆ Hunters must remain on US Army Corps of Engineers property. Surrounding property, including the barn near Miti, is private property. **Trespassing is not allowed.**
- ◆ Hunting not permitted within 100 yards of campgrounds including Miti Campground.
- ◆ Boat hunting must be within 100 yards of shore high water line bordering the designated hunting area.
- ◆ All hunters must follow California hunting regulations and US Army Corps of Engineers Title 36 park regulations.
- ◆ Motorized vehicles are prohibited in the Wildlife Management Area.

## Turkey Hunting

- ◆ Turkey hunting permits are issued by lottery through California Department of Fish and Game.
- ◆ Junior Hunts and General Hunts are offered each Fall and Spring
- ◆ Contact the California Department of Fish and Game or Lake Mendocino Park Office for more information

**Be Aware! - Hikers, mountain bikers, and horseback riders use the Wildlife Management Area also!**

## Firearms

- ◆ Hunting with shotguns only.
- ◆ Shotgun ammunition is restricted to steel or lead shot.
- ◆ The use of pistols, rifles and shotgun slugs are prohibited.
- ◆ Firearms **MUST** be unloaded when transporting outside hunting area.
- ◆ Firearms are allowed at Lake Mendocino **ONLY** during hunting season in the designated hunting area. All other times of the year firearms are prohibited.
