**JUVENILE POLICY
LAKE MENDOCINO
Federal code of regulations
(Title 36, Chapter III, Section 327.12a)**

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers under the authority of the Federal Code of Regulations, has placed the following restrictions on the use of all camping facilities at Lake Mendocino. These restrictions are implemented for the protection of juveniles and others, and for the safety and welfare of the general public.

Lake Mendocino has adopted the following policy:

Juveniles (persons under the age of 18 years), unaccompanied by an adult, must be in possession of a written letter of permission from their parent(s), providing parent names(s), residence address, and telephone number of the juveniles' parent(s) or guardian (s), and the inclusive dates for which permission is granted. This written letter of permission must be furnished to park personnel upon request. Failure to provide such information, may result in a request to leave the park.
