

**ARROYO DE LA LAGUNA
GENERAL INVESTIGATIONS**

PROJECT LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION: Arroyo de la Laguna is located in Alameda County, about 25 miles southeast of San Francisco, California. Arroyo de la Laguna collects and drains runoff from Livermore, Dublin and Pleasanton into Alameda Creek; a number of tributaries extend into Contra Costa and Santa Clara Counties. The upper basin is approximately 15 miles wide, 45 miles long and covers about 398,000 acres. This study would evaluate Federal interest in solutions to potential flooding and associated damage to surrounding riparian habitat.

FY 04 ACCOMPLISHMENTS: The Reconnaissance Study will result in a 905(b) Analysis in September 2004.

FY 05 ACCOMPLISHMENTS: If Federal interest is indicated and funds permit, FY05 will see preparation, negotiation and signing of a Program Management Plan and Feasibility Cost Sharing Agreement. With a positive 905(b) analysis and signed plan and agreement, the project will be ready for Federal and local funding and start of the Feasibility Study.

ISSUES AND OTHER INFORMATION: FY05 tasks are not funded in the budget. This lack of funding will prevent the initiation of the Program Management Plan, Feasibility Cost Sharing Agreement and Feasibility Study in 2005. Ramifications of this study delay are not yet known but have the potential to be considerable.
