

**NAPA VALLEY WATERSHED MANAGEMENT
GENERAL INVESTIGATIONS**

PROJECT LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION: The Napa Valley Watershed is located within the northern portion of the San Pablo Bay drainage basin in Napa County, California. The project purpose is to provide technical, planning, and design assistance to the non-Federal interests for carrying out watershed management, restoration and development in the Napa River Watershed. A watershed plan would incorporate flood protection and environmental restoration to address watershed problems and opportunities through water and related land resource management.

FY 05 ACCOMPLISHMENTS: Complete the Napa Valley Watershed Information Center and continue work on the *Napa Valley Watershed: A Foundation for Resources Management and Restoration*.

ISSUES AND OTHER INFORMATION: The Napa County Board of Supervisors appointed a Napa Valley Watershed Conservancy Board and Technical Review Panel. These locally organized lead entities are critical to the on-going development of study tasks and the completion of the watershed management plan.
