

**THOMPSON CREEK**  
**CONTINUING AUTHORITY, SECTION 206**

PROJECT LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION: Thompson Creek is located in Santa Clara County, about 30 miles south of San Francisco, California. The project boundaries lie east of Highway 101 and Southeast of Highway 680, in the Coyote Creek Watershed. The proposed project will focus on aquatic restoration along the riparian corridor of Thompson Creek. The non-Federal sponsor is the Santa Clara Valley Water District (SCVWD).

FY 04 ACCOMPLISHMENTS: A Preliminary Restoration Plan (PRP) has been submitted for approval. Should the PRP be approved, the Detailed Project Report will be initiated in FY04.

FY 05 ACCOMPLISHMENTS: Continue the Detailed Project Report effort. Projected identification of the National Environmental Plan.

ISSUES AND OTHER INFORMATION: When first proposed in FY2002, the project was called the Santa Clara Valley Aquatic Restoration, Section 206. It was decided the proposed project was overly broad for Section 206 Authority. In FY2003 the local sponsor agreed to narrow the focus of the project to aquatic restoration in Thompson Creek. Consequently, the project was renamed Thompson Creek.
