

**PETALUMA RIVER
OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE**

PROJECT LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION: The Petaluma River is located in Sonoma and Marin Counties, California on San Pablo Bay. Project operations and maintenance provides for maintenance dredging of a channel 200 feet wide and -8 feet deep across the flats in San Pablo Bay to the mouth of the river; thence 100 feet wide and -8 feet deep to Western Avenue in Petaluma, including a turning basin 300 to 400 feet wide and -8 feet deep; thence 50 feet wide and -4 feet deep to Washington Street in Petaluma. The City of Petaluma is the local sponsor.
