

**FISHERMAN'S WHARF
OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE**

PROJECT LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION: This project provides a protected harbor adequate to serve the existing fishing fleet, and protection to the Federally owned historic fleet (National Park Service) at Fisherman's Wharf, San Francisco, California. Originally constructed in 1988, the project includes a 1,509 foot long solid concrete sheet pile breakwater located along the west side of Pier 45, and a 150 foot long segmented concrete sheet pile breakwater located on the northeastern side of Pier 45.

FY 04 AND 05 ACCOMPLISHMENTS: Periodic inspection will be conducted to monitor scouring action and structure condition.

ISSUES AND OTHER INFORMATION: Scour actions that occurred along the toe of the detached breakwater was corrected in FY92 by placement of 5,400 tons of rock and filter material. Subsequent scour protection has not been necessary.
