

**CALERA CREEK
CONTINUING AUTHORITY, SECTION 206**

PROJECT LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION: Calera Creek is located about 15 miles south of San Francisco, California in the city of Pacifica, San Mateo County. The city of Pacifica would like to initiate a Section 206 habitat restoration study under the Continuing Authorities Program (CAP), but lack of funding has precluded initiation of the study phase.
