

**CARMEL RIVER CSA-50
CONTINUING AUTHORITY, SECTION 205**

PROJECT LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION: Carmel River is located in Monterey County about 100 miles south of San Francisco, California. The Monterey County Water Resource Agency would like to initiate a Section 205 flood damage prevention study under Continuing Authorities Program (CAP), but lack of funding has precluded initiation of the study phase.
