

**PAVON CREEK RESTORATION
CONTINUING AUTHORITY, SECTION 206**

PROJECT LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION: This project is located in Contra Costa County, California. The proposed project modifications include planting and bioengineering techniques designed to restore riparian habitat and provide erosion protection for creek banks to improve water quality and stream channel habitats. Specifically, these modifications improve habitat for federally threatened steelhead trout as well as for additional native plant and animal species.
