

**SAN PABLO CREEK
CONTINUING AUTHORITY, SECTION 205**

PROJECT LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION: The proposed project is located in the East Bay of the San Francisco Bay Metropolitan Area, in the City of Orinda, Contra Costa County, California. Flooding on the San Pablo Creek affects the city of Orinda on the west side of Highway 24. During the last El Nino event, the City of Orinda experienced damage to residential and commercial interests when the San Pablo Creek overtopped its banks under flood conditions. The non-Federal sponsor is the City of Orinda.
