

**THOMPSON CREEK  
CONTINUING AUTHORITY, SECTION 206**

PROJECT LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION: Thompson Creek is located in Santa Clara County, about 30 miles south of San Francisco, California. The project boundaries lie east of Highway 101 and Southeast of Highway 680, in the Coyote Creek Watershed. The proposed project will focus on aquatic restoration along the riparian corridor of Thompson Creek from Quimby Road to Aborn Road. The non-Federal sponsor is the Santa Clara Valley Water District.

FY 07 ACCOMPLISHMENTS: No work is anticipated for FY07 since the study was not earmarked. Those studies named in appropriations reports are given higher priority for funding.

ISSUES AND OTHER INFORMATION: When first proposed in FY02, the project was called the Santa Clara Valley Aquatic Restoration, Section 206. It was decided the proposed project was overly broad for Section 206 Authority. In FY03 the local sponsor agreed to narrow the focus of the project to aquatic restoration in Thompson Creek. Consequently, the project was renamed Thompson Creek.
