

**FISHERMANS WHARF
OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE**

PROJECT LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION: This project provides protection to the existing fishing fleet and the Federally owned historic fleet (National Park Service) at Fishermans Wharf, San Francisco, California. Originally constructed in 1988, the project includes a 1,509 foot long solid concrete sheet pile breakwater located along the west side of Pier 45, and a two segmented concrete sheet pile breakwaters 252 feet and 150 feet long, located on the northeastern side of Pier 45.
