The U.S Army Corps of Engineers San Francisco District (District) cordially invites you to participate in a virtual charrette to discuss comments you submitted on the draft Project Management Plan (PMP) for the San Francisco Bay Regional Dredge Material Management Plan (RDDMP). We had planned for an in-person charrette but unfortunately, due to the pandemic, we can no longer do that. However, we value and appreciate your input, so we have decided to hold a series of virtual charrettes to address comments and scope supporting work products. These charrettes are organized into four comment including:

- 1-Toxicology
- 2-Climate Change and Other Environmental Issues
- 3-Physical Processes --sediment transport, sea walls, erosion controls, etc.
- 4-Economics, Social Studies and Policies
- 5-Summary and Next Steps

WHY: The District held a public meeting to reintroduce the Regional DMMP effort on July 19, 2019, that provided details about our process for completing a DMMP. We provided a “bare-bones” draft PMP on the website to provide an example of the document that we seek for your inputs and comments. We developed a project website for you to submit your comments and recommendations about the scope of this effort. Now that we have your comments, we are holding a series of virtual charrettes to discuss your concerns and collectively come up with the path forward to complete the PMP. WHAT: We seek your input as we develop the Project Management Plan (PMP) for the San Francisco Bay DMMP. The PMP serves as a roadmap and guides the overall scope, quality of work products, changes to the project, risks to project execution and internal and external communication matrix. These charrettes will help us scope supporting products to frame sustainable dredging and placement solutions.
