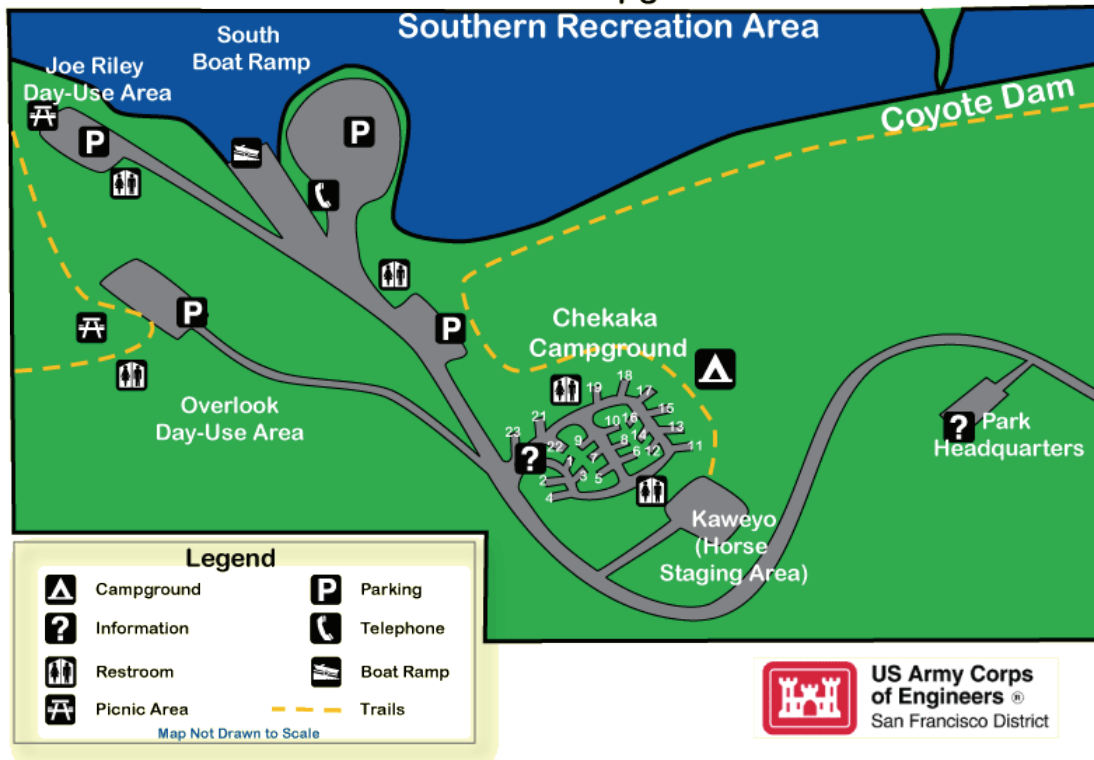


Lake Mendocino

Directions

From 101 South (San Francisco, Santa Rosa, Ukiah)

Follow Highway 101 North. Take the Lake Mendocino exit just North of Ukiah. Turn right onto Lake Mendocino Drive. At the stoplight, turn left onto State Street. At the next stoplight, turn right onto Lake Mendocino Drive. Follow Lake Mendocino Drive to the end. Check in at the Host Booth on your right at the top of the hill before going to your campsite.

From 101 North (Eureka, Willits, Fort Bragg)

Follow Highway 101 South. Take the Lake Mendocino exit about 3 miles South of the Highway 20 East interchange. Turn left onto Lake Mendocino Drive. At the stoplight, turn left onto State Street. At the next stoplight, turn right onto Lake Mendocino Drive. Follow Lake Mendocino Drive to the end. Check in at the Host Booth on your right at the top of the hill before going to your campsite.

From 20 East (Sacramento)

Take Highway 20 West from Williams. Follow Highway 20 past Clearlake and Blue Lakes to Highway 101. Take Highway 101 South to the Lake Mendocino Drive exit, approximately 3 miles South the Highway 20 East interchange. Turn left onto Lake Mendocino Drive. At the stoplight, turn left onto State Street. At the next stoplight, turn right onto Lake Mendocino Drive. Follow Lake Mendocino Drive to the end. Check in at the Host Booth on your right at the top of the hill before going to your campsite.
