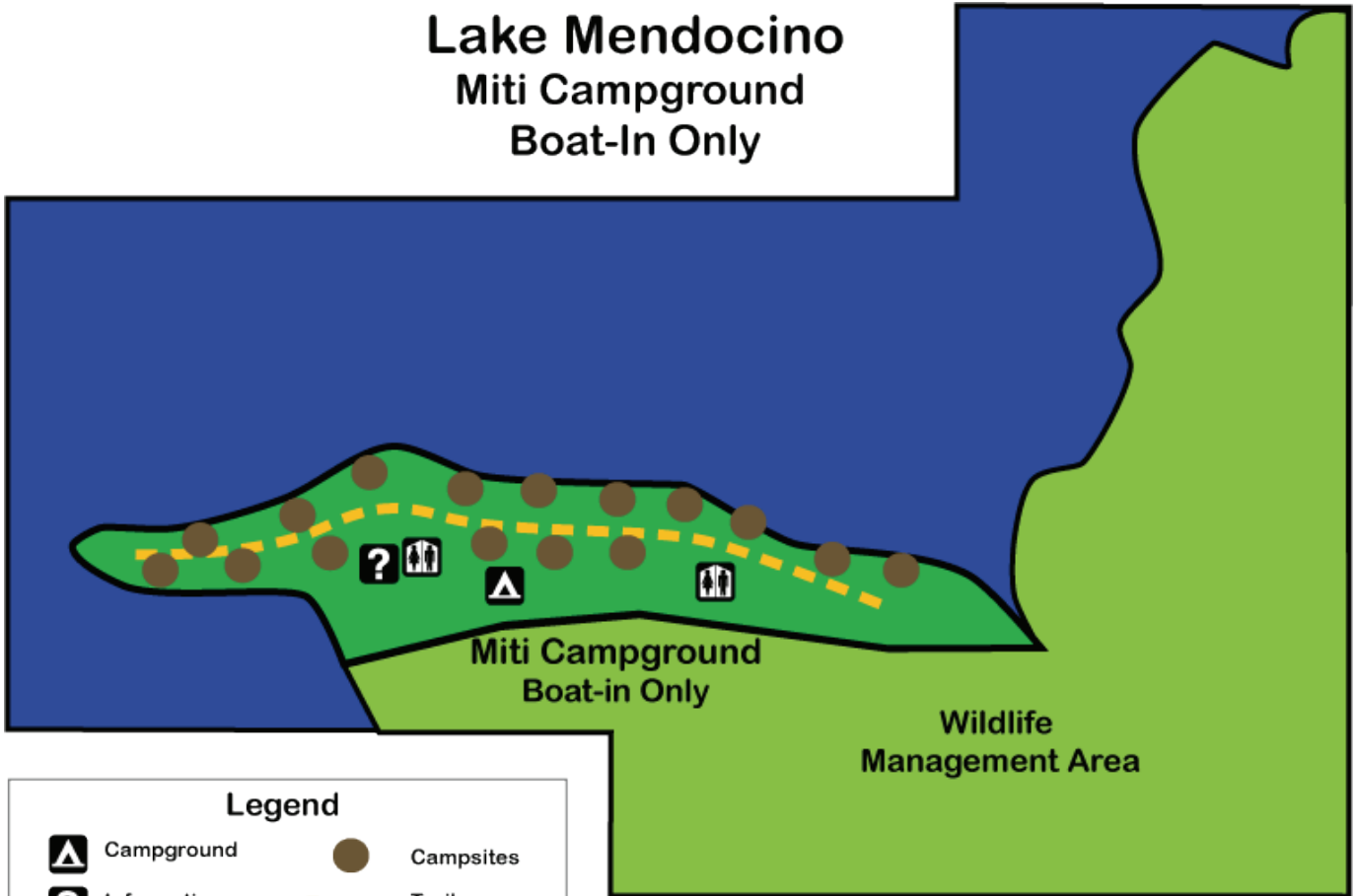








Lake Mendocino Miti Campground Boat-In Only

Registering at Miti

Pay the \$3 launch fee at either the North or South Boat Ramps and post receipt on the dash of your vehicle. A properly displayed annual boat launch pass is also acceptable.

When you arrive at Miti, choose your campsite(s) at Miti and pay the \$8 nightly camping fee. Envelopes and instructions are at the bulletin board near campsite #5.

Pay by cash or check. Checks should be made out to NRRS.

A uniformed ranger will issue registration passes. Be sure to hang the car registration tag from your rearview mirror as soon as possible.
