## REQUEST TO ALTER US ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS CIVIL WORKS PROJECT PURSUANT TO 33 USC 408 (SECTION 408)

Requester: Alameda County Flood Control and Water Conservation District

**Alteration Being Proposed**: Construction of approximately 1.2 miles of new paved multi-use public trail along San Leandro Creek Flood Control Project.

**Description of Alteration**: The purpose of the proposed project is to construct a 1.2 miles Class I multi-use trail as part of a continuous greenway corridor providing connections from the Bay Trail at the MLK Jr. Regional Shoreline Park and connect this path to the Columbia Gardens, Brookfield Village and Sobrante Park neighborhoods, activity centers and key neighborhood bus transit node. This route also provides direct connections from the neighborhoods to the Coliseum BART station and to job centers around the Hegenberger Road and 98th Avenue corridors. The trail will be ADA accessible.

**Location of Alteration**: The proposed trail project limits will be from Hegenberger Road to 105th Avenue upstream in Oakland, CA. The proposed trail will go along the existing flood control maintenance access road on the south side of earth and concrete channels to near the upstream end of concrete channel. The proposed trail will continue to the north side of the concrete channel via a new prefabricated pedestrian bridge, going under the UPRR bridge and under the I-880 freeway and ending at 105th Ave.
