Section 1002 of the Water Resources Reform and Development Act of 2014 requires the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers District Engineer to notify non-federal sponsors regarding feasibility study milestone schedules for active studies.

The baseline schedule for the Oakland Harbor Turning Basins Widening Feasibility Study in Oakland, CA is as follows:

- a. Release of Draft Report 17 December 2021 (achieved)
- b. District Engineer submits final feasibility report 27 Jan 2023
- c. Signed Chief's Report 25 May 2023

Public comments received on the Draft Report released on 17 Dec 2021 resulted in a shift of the proposed footprint for the inner basin. This shift triggered additional environmental compliance that will require public review and comment. In coordination with your staff, we will prepare a 3x3x3 exemption request to rerelease the Draft Report and extend the completion dates for the milestones above, subject to approval by the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Civil Works).
