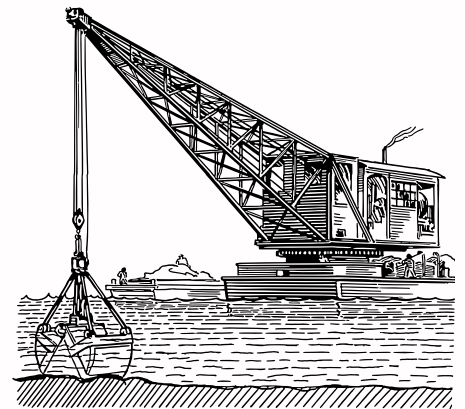


Crescent City Harbor Dredged Material Management Plan

Background

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers San Francisco District is working with the Crescent City Harbor District to complete a Dredged Material Management Plan (DMMP) in an effort to plan for the next 20 years of placement for dredged material in the harbor. There is a public meeting on July 27, 2021 at 7 PM to ask for public input on the current alternatives that have been proposed. The Corps is looking to inform the public of the DMMP, current alternatives, and collaborate on the alternative analysis.



Alternatives Analysis

1. Whaler Island (available: sandy material only)
 2. Outer Breakwater Beach Nourishment (unavailable: sandy material only)
 3. Humboldt Open Ocean Disposal Site (available: clean sandy and fine grained material)
 4. New Ocean Disposal Site (unavailable: clean sandy and fine grained material)
 5. Beneficial Reuse (unavailable: no known shore/upland sites currently)

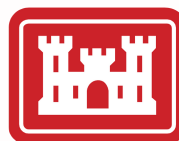
