2. The South Pacific Division San Francisco District Support Team (DST) has reviewed the San Francisco District (SPN) Review Plan (RP) and has verified that the RP complies with current policy requirements.

3. Consistent with EC 1165-2-217 (Reference 1.b.), the need for a Safety Assurance Review (SAR) was conducted and as per regulation, the District Chief of Engineering, as the Engineer in Responsible Charge, has assessed that there is no significant risk to life and safety. This determination is also reflected in the Feasibility Review plan and the approval listed in reference 1.a.

4. The DST has reviewed the RP, dated March 2020, found it to be sufficient, and it is hereby approved.
