Shively Summer Bridge Crossing


<u>Location of project</u>: Section 29, Township 1, North, Range 2 East, H.B.M., Redcrest USGS Quadrangle, south east of community of Pepperwood, east of Hwy 101 and Hwy 254 (Avenue of Giants) on main stem of Eel River, west of community of Shively, in Humboldt County, California.


Exit off Hwy 101 at the Holmes Pepperwood exit onto Hwy 254 (Avenue of the Giants) just before or after mile post 43.2 (depending on direction coming from) Shively sign denotes ROE through State Parks to access the Eel River and the Shively Summer Bridge project.




Permits: CDFW 1600

- North Coast Water Quality Brd permit has been issued and attached. State Lands of California general permit has been issued and attached.
- ROE thru State Parks has been issued and attached. This permit is applied for yearly by Humboldt Co. Dept. of Public Works. Typically, the application is submitted in May for June issue.
 ITP (Incidental Take Permit) for the Foothill Yellow Legged Frog is in process again by the Humboldt Co. Dept of Public Works permitting division.


